

**Human Resources Support Services Health, Wellness and Safety****General Safety Rules (2.1.1)****PURPOSE TO PROVIDE A TEMPLATE FOR ENVIRONMENTAL HEALTH AND SAFETY IN ALL LOCATIONS****REFERENCE PEEL DISTRICT SCHOOL BOARD PROCEDURES, APPLICABLE LEGISLATION, STANDARDS AND CODES**

The Peel District School Board of Education requires strict application of the following procedures as mandated by the Occupational Health and Safety Act and Regulations:

- where there is a risk of head injury, appropriate head protection shall be worn
- where there is a risk of eye injury, appropriate eye protection shall be worn
- where there is a risk of foot injury, appropriate foot protection shall be worn
- where there is a risk of hearing loss, appropriate hearing protection shall be worn
- where there is a risk of injury to the skin, appropriate gloves or clothing shall be worn

**NOTE:** Where a CSA Standard is referred to in the Occupational Health and Safety Act or Regulations, personal protective equipment shall comply with that Standard. In any event, where no external Standard exists, the Peel District School Board of Education will set the appropriate safety Standard.

All staff will be familiar with the procedures contained in this manual, and will cross reference the appropriate section when additional specific information is required.

Section 2 of this manual will provide health, safety or environmental procedures where legislated or recommended by the Peel District School Board administration. The Board is committed to a philosophy of providing a safe working environment for staff and students.

The following general procedures apply across the Board and are to be taken into consideration prior to any activity which may impact on staff or students.
