- Courses run from 6:00 p.m. to 9:30 p.m.

Registration

- Students may take only one night school credit at a time per semester.
- Peel DSB and Dufferin-Peel DSB day school students must be registered by the guidance counsellors at the home schools.
- Guidance counsellors of day school students from neighbouring boards and private schools may fax the registration form (signed by a parent and the guidance counsellor) to Continuing Education at 905-270-1050.
- Adults must register in person at Continuing Education and bring a transcript and proof of citizenship.
- All registration ends by the second night of classes.
