# CREDIT PROGRAM INFORMATION

## DATES AND TIMES

## FORMATION OF CLASSES

All classes are conditional on space, teacher availability and sufficient enrolment and so may be cancelled or transferred to a different location than listed. For make-up credits we cannot guarantee a choice of course date

## WHAT IS THE ATTENDANCE POLICY?

A student who has registered for a credit course but does not attend the first class may not be admitted to the course.

Regular attendance is crucial for success in summer school. One day of summer school is equivalent to more than one week of instruction in the regular school year. A student is expected to be punctual and attend every day. Absence from summer school for personal activities or vacation is **not** acceptable.

Abuse of this attendance policy will result in withdrawal from class. A student may be withdrawn after one unacceptable absence.

## IS THERE HOMEWORK?

Summer school courses cover an entire year's work in a compressed period of time and students must be prepared to allocate sufficient time to work at home every day. It is not advisable to pursue daily employment.

## WHEN ARE FINAL EXAMINATIONS WRITTEN?

Examinations will be written as determined by the site administrator.

## WHEN DO I GET MY REPORT?

Interim Report For New Credits and Full Make-up Credits, students will receive an interim progress report on the 10<sup>th</sup> day of the program.

Final Report For Session 1 Make-up Credits, students will receive their final reports and review their exams on the last day of the 10 day program.

For Session 2 Make-up Credits, Full Make-up Credits and New Credits, students will receive their final reports and review their exams on the last day of the 20 day program.

A mark will be submitted to the student's home school for any day school student who attended summer school and was issued a mid-term or final report card.
