

## CREATIVE PLAYGROUNDS

### Statement of Policy

The Peel District School Board supports the establishment of creative playgrounds on school sites.

This policy is aligned with and supports the principles and expectations of the Board's Human Rights policy ([Policy 51](#)) and the Equity and Inclusive Education policy ([Policy 54](#)). At all times, this policy should be interpreted to be consistent with the Board's policies and the *Human Rights Code*.

### Administrative Regulations

The Director and Associate Directors are authorized to approve the construction of creative playgrounds on school sites, under the following conditions:

1. That a community committee, in cooperation with the school principal, assume responsibility for preparation of a plan for the project.
2. That the plan for the project be approved by the Controller of Facilities and Environmental Support Services for the Peel District School Board in terms of location and safety.
3. That the community committee will be responsible for obtaining agreement to the plan from the residents adjacent to the proposed site in accordance with the Environmental Health & Safety Manual section 2.22.1. The Director and Associate Directors will make the determination on the adequacy of public support under A4 of said Operating Procedure.
4. That the community committee will be responsible for all costs associated with the project.
5. That the Peel District School Board be responsible for the performance of all maintenance work on creative playgrounds constructed on school property.
