

**LUNCH AND NUTRITION BREAK SUPERVISION - ELEMENTARY SCHOOLS****Statement of Policy**

The Peel District School Board will ensure that pupils remaining at school for lunch or nutrition breaks are adequately supervised.

This policy is aligned with and supports the principles and expectations of the Board's Human Rights policy ([Policy 51](#)) and the Equity and Inclusive Education policy ([Policy 54](#)). At all times, this policy should be interpreted to be consistent with the Board's policies and the *Human Rights Code*.

**Administrative Regulations**

- a) It shall be understood that the lunch or nutrition break supervision is under the direction of the principal of individual schools. Plans for supervision will be reviewed by Superintendents of Education on an annual basis.
- b) It shall be understood that a pupil who remains at school for the lunch or nutrition breaks shall not leave the school premises without the authority of the pupil's parent in writing and without the express approval of the principal.
